Description of Landscape and Grounds Management

The landscape and grounds management curriculum is designed to educate students in the application of basic principles to the installation and management of environmentally sound landscapes, grounds, and interiorscapes. These functions include wetlands reclamation, replacement, and enhancement; minimization of the impact of agricultural chemicals on the environment; landscape waste management; and water quality and conservation in the home landscape and grounds, on the golf course, at amusement parks, commercial buildings and offices, and outdoor athletic facilities. A graduate with the landscape and grounds management major will have the education necessary for employment in this growing and prosperous profession.
